Dear Friends of Casuarina Coastal Reserve, Casuarina and Rapid Creek Landcares,

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the questionnaire. I refer to the letter from the Chief Minister in relation to the questions asked, with the exception of number 1 to which I add:

As the Member for Casuarina I have been involved with the Casuarina Landcare for a decade. If re-elected I will continue to advocate for increased operational funding, and note that costing waste removal and maintenance work is underway. I support looking at options to reduce the burden of some of the visitor management tasks on our Rangers, recognising the significant increase to visitor numbers in the Reserve over the last decade and the impact it has on workload.

I have supported calls for increased land to be incorporated into the Reserve, and the process for consideration of the Reserve to become a Park, both of which have been successful.

Being involved in the Landcare Working Bees for so long and to get to know your volunteers is a great privilege - I understand the issues in the Reserve and will continue to be a champion for it.
